A top-of-the-world cultural event, the 13th Panhellenic Symposium of Epicurean Philosophy took place on the weekend of 11 and 12 February 2023 with the participation of about three hundred Greeks inspired by the enlightening and humanistic philosophy of Epicurus. This is a unique philosophical conference, as it is the only one organized worldwide dedicated exclusively to Epicurean philosophy. It is also the largest national philosophical conference and the only one in Greece that has been established since 2011 as an institution from the people rather than from the university philosophers. It is organized annually with free entrance for the public by the Municipality of Pallini and the Friends of Epicurean Philosophy "Garden of Athens" and "Garden of Salonica" at the Cultural Center of Gerakas, located within the ancient area of Gargettus, from which the philosopher Epicurus originated from. The previous two Panhellenic Symposia were virtually organized due to the coronavirus pandemic.
